ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Internship applicants must be full-time college students with a high school diploma or equivalent. They must also be in the process of completing or have recently completed a program of study in their area of interest or a related discipline. Recent graduates are eligible to participate in the internship programs throughout the year following graduation.

Due to the nature of our business, applicants who wish to participate in the internship programs must be available to work a variety of shifts, including evenings, weekends and holidays. Additionally, most positions require interns to be available to work full-time hours.



THE APPLICATION PROCESS

Individuals who wish to be considered for one or more of the internship programs must submit an application for employment at **nemacolin.com/careers**. Two professional letters of recommendation are required, and candidates must successfully complete a pre-employment drug screen and criminal background check as a condition of employment.

AFTER THE APPLICATION

Once you have completed the online application, please be patient as we receive hundreds of applications for our internship programs each year. If you are selected to participate in the interview process, a recruiter or department representative will contact you via telephone or email. Applicants typically complete a prescreen interview prior to interviewing with specific department managers. The entire selection process can take several weeks to complete, but all applicants are notified via email after the final selections have been made.
